Program Description:

This is a week-long, 9am - 4pm program.

Pottery wheel campers will produce several pieces. Each camper will design their own version of these projects. Smaller projects, chosen from the list provided the first day, are available throughout the week, time permitting. They will also design their own Camp Shirt, and decorate invites to the Art Show.

Fee Structure

- The fee for camp weeks #1, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10 is \$325
 - The fee for camp weeks #2, 5, 6 is \$350
 - The fee for camp weeks #3 and 3.5 is \$175
 - All Supplies are included
- Payment in full is required with registration. Registration fee is non-refundable*
 - Ice cream after lunch (optional) is about \$3.00 in cash/day
(Or \$20 per week, change returned)

Parent Checklist:

1. Please go over your child's allergies with us when you arrive the first day.
2. Send your children in CLOTHES & SHOES THAT CAN BE DIRTIED.
3. We require **prompt drop off BY 9:00 AM and pick-up AT 4:00 PM**, unless pre-arranged for early/late pick/drop off.
 - a. Unless pre-arranged with front desk, **NO ONE LEAVES BEFORE CLEAN-UP.**
4. If early or late parent pick-up required:
 - a. We need to know at start of week if possible. (Fee will be incurred for late p/u.)
 - b. If child is sick one day, **PLEASE call us, so we don't wait to start, 354-4318.**
 - c. **If your child is sick or tardy: Due to the nature of this camp program, missed days due to illness or any other obligations, cannot be "made up" at another time. Extreme cases will need to be discussed on a case-by-case basis.**
5. Please have your child pre-lotioned with sunscreen lotion EACH DAY, no matter what the forecast.
6. Lunch:
 - a. Please provide a backpack so your child can transport his/her lunch to the park.
 - b. We expect them to eat... and will check before they play. Please tell us your expectations. If you do not require us to check if they've eaten, please tell us.
 - c. Please provide extra water for drinking.
 - d. We may not go to the park every day due to inclement weather, or the need to complete projects. This will be determined on a day to day basis.
7. Water Play: (Participation is up to your child)
 - a. Water gun & Extra water for gun refills.
 - b. Bathing suit (or change of shorts and undies) & Towel
 - c. Water shoes of some sort. (Mandatory. Children MAY NOT go barefoot in the park)
8. Theme Days:

To help your child prepare for the theme days, here are some tips:

 - a. **Tuesday: Crazy Hair Day** Go Wild! Color, objects and/or younger siblings in hair; be creative.
 - b. **Wednesday: Bring a real pet day**, (if allowed). Parent must stay till 9:20 to take pet home.

Your child may "Invent a Pet" and bring it in, i.e. pet rock, pet stick, favorite stuffed animal, picture of their real pet. ONE pet per person.
 - c. **Thursday: "Way Out" Artist Day**...Go wilder, clothes, hair, hat, anything you can think of.
 - d. **Friday: Camper's Choice Day** Campers will discuss and decide what this Day will be when they do their "meet and greet" on Monday morning.
9. Please give your child's Ice Cream Money to the appointed staff member.

Class Trips:

Parents will be advised of the days of field trips, parents can choose whether their camper can go and then provide them with money to spend.
